Racial/Ethnic Minority Attorneys: Attorney Statistical Profile (2016-17)

This report profiles active racial/ethnic minority attorney members of the State Bar of Texas as of December 31, 2016. Not all demographic data is provided by every attorney. Separate population totals are provided in italics in each category that is lacking all demographic data. Percentages may not sum to one hundred due to rounding. Over the last 10 years the number of racial/ethnic minority Texas attorneys has increased by 71 percent, growing from 11,060 attorneys in 2006 to 18,924 in 2016.
