This report profiles active State Bar of Texas attorney members with membership in the State Bar of Texas as of December 31, 2017. Not all demographic data is provided by every attorney. Over the last 10 years the number of Texas attorneys has increased by 25 percent, growing from 81,601 attorneys in 2007 to 102,044 in 2017.
