



Randall L. Sarosdy currently serves as General Counsel of the Texas Justice Court Training Center. Mr. Sarosdy practiced law for nearly 30 years with the law firm of Akin, Gump, Strauss, Hauer & Feld, L.L.P. in Washington, D.C. and Austin, where he served as lead trial and appellate counsel in complex commercial, intellectual property, energy and labor cases throughout the country.
