ORDER REVOKING CONDITIONS OF RELEASE AND ORDER OF DETENTION

CAME ON for consideration the United States' Second Motion to Revoke Defendant Kmiec's Appearance Bond (Doc. 26) filed on June 21, 2019.¹

On January 2, 2018, U.S. Bankruptcy Judge David Jones issued an Amended Order of Civil Contempt that prohibited Defendant from "owning, keeping or caring for any animals" until December 11, 2027. <u>See</u> Gov't Ex. 2, Amended Order of Civil Contempt. In support of this ruling, the court cited Defendant's non-compliance with the court's earlier injunction by "cruelly confining animals in their own feces in small containers without adequate ventilation," preventing inspections of her property to ensure compliance with the injunction, and disabling a GPS monitor that a U.S. District Judge required her to wear. See id.

On May 29, 2019, Defendant made her initial appearance before Judge Stacy on the pending criminal charges for bankruptcy fraud. See Doc. 19, Transcript. During the discussion on the terms of her

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release, the government argued that Defendant continued to violate Judge Jones's order based on reports that barking had been heard by Defendant's neighbors earlier that month. <u>See</u> Doc. 19, Transcript p. 7. The case agent informed Judge Stacy that the case agent believed there were at least three dogs on Defendant's property based on her investigation. <u>See</u> Doc. 19, Transcript p. 13. Defendant objected to any condition of release that would allow a rescue group to rescue animals on her property. <u>See</u> Doc. 19, Transcript pp. 8-14. Defendant's counsel agreed that "if she finds out that there are any dogs on or near her property. <u>See</u> Doc. 19, Transcript p. 13. The government continued to press for a condition of release that required removal of any dogs from Defendant's property. <u>See</u> Doc. 19, Transcript pp. 14, 20-22.

After this lengthy discussion in the presence of Defendant, Judge Stacy set conditions of release and read Defendant those conditions. <u>See</u> Doc. 11, Order Setting Conditions of Release; Doc. 19 Transcript pp. 24-28. One of those conditions was that Defendant was prohibited from owning, keeping, or caring for any animals for the period stated in the Bankruptcy Court's Order. <u>See</u> Doc. 11, Order Setting Conditions of Release p. 2. Defendant was also ordered to comply with all court orders, and was given fortyeight hours to remove all animals from her property. <u>See id.</u>

On June 6, 2019, the United States filed its first motion to

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revoke Defendant's bond. <u>See</u> Doc. 14, United States' Motion to Revoke. In the motion, the United States complained that the court's Order Setting Conditions of Release required Defendant to turn over any animals on her property to three animal rescue agencies and that Defendant had failed to turn over any animals as ordered. <u>See</u> Doc. 14, United States' Motion to Revoke p. 2.

In response, Defendant argued that there was no evidence that Defendant had any animals on her property after she was placed on bond. See Doc. 15, Defendant's Response p. 2.

On June 21, 2019, the United States filed its Second Motion to Revoke Bond (Doc. 26). In the motion, the United States provided evidence that on June 5, 2019, Defendant checked into the La Quinta Hotel in Tomball, Texas, representing that she was only going to stay several days. <u>See</u> Doc. 26, Second Motion to Revoke Bond p. 3. Defendant completed a pet policy form for her stay at the hotel. <u>See</u> Gov't Ex. 7. Defendant used her father's name on the hotel registration, not her own name. <u>See</u> Gov't Ex. 4. The government provided pictures of Defendant checking into the hotel and moving dog kennels inside the hotel. <u>See</u> Gov't Exs. 14 and 15. One hotel employee assisted Defendant in moving three animal kennels from Defendant's vehicle.

Special Agent Alisa Mahabir testified that she spoke to several of Defendant's neighbors, who reported hearing dogs barking through May 2019. Neighbors also observed Defendant unloading dog

food from her van.

Special Agent Mahabir spoke with employees of the La Quinta Hotel. They reported that other guests repeatedly complained about dogs barking, animal smells and all-night, blaring television noise coming from Defendant's room. Hotel management asked Defendant to check out of the hotel on June 14, 2019, because of those complaints. Special Agent Mahabir saw Defendant moving bins into her car on June 14, 2019, but did not see any dogs. <u>See</u> Gov't Exs. 3, 3-a.

Special Agent Mahabir and a hotel employee thereafter inspected Defendant's room immediately after she vacated it. The carpet was covered with large clumps of dog hair. <u>See</u> Gov't Exs. 8, 9, and 10. The air conditioning vents were covered in dog hair. <u>See</u> Gov't Exs. 9, 10. A hotel employee told Agent Mahabir that the employee had observed Defendant with an animal in a kennel but could not identify the animal as a dog.

Special Agent Mahabir also spoke with two relatives of Defendant who both verified that between June 11-12, 2019, Defendant had attempted to off-load her dogs to them. Admitted into evidence were text messages from Defendant to these relatives that confirm that Defendant had four dogs that she wanted these relatives to board immediately. <u>See</u> Gov't Exs. 16, 16-a.

Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 3148(b)(1)(B) and (b)(2)(B), the court may revoke an order setting conditions of release upon finding by clear and convincing evidence that: (1) the defendant

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violated a condition of release; and (2) the defendant is unlikely to abide by any condition or combination of conditions of release.

Based on the foregoing, the court finds by clear and convincing evidence that Defendant possessed dogs at the La Quinta Hotel from at least June 5, 2019, through June 14, 2019, in violation of the conditions of release.

The court finds by clear and convincing evidence that Defendant's movement of the dogs to the hotel was an attempt to conceal her wrongful possession of the dogs and to manipulate her attorney. <u>See</u> Doc. 13, Sealed Document.

The court finds by clear and convincing evidence that Defendant knew that her possession of these dogs violated Judge Jones's injunction, his Amended Order of Civil Contempt of January 2, 2018, and Judge Stacy's Order Setting Conditions of Release.

The court further finds that there are no conditions or combination of conditions that would assure Defendant's compliance with court orders in the future. Defendant has violated three court orders. There is no basis from which this court could conclude that Defendant would comply with future court orders based on her past performance.

Defendant's counsel argued that if the court found a violation of the court's order, a possible sanction/solution might be to order that Defendant wear a GPS monitor. The court rejects this suggestion as location monitoring does not address Defendant's repeated violations of court orders; it only addresses flight

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concerns which are not present here. It is also ironic that Defendant is offering to wear a GPS monitor as an option when another judge attempted to use a GPS monitor to obtain compliance with earlier court orders. Defendant cut off that GPS monitor.

Defendant also argued that her current medical condition and need for crutches should factor into the court's decision on whether to revoke her release. The United States objected and argued that the court should not rely on this proffer given Defendant's history of misrepresentations. Even if the court were to accept as true Defendant's representation that she has a torn ACL ligament and a broken knee cap, those facts do not move the court to continue her release in light of her long history of violating court orders.

In light of the foregoing, the Order Setting Conditions of Release is **REVOKED**. Defendant is **REMANDED** to custody.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that Defendant is committed to the custody of the Attorney General or his designated representative for confinement in a corrections facility separate, to the extent practicable, from persons awaiting or serving sentences or being held in custody pending appeal. The defendant shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity for private consultation with defense counsel. On order of a court of the United States or on request of an attorney for the Government, the person in charge of the corrections facility shall deliver the defendant to the United States Marshal for the purpose of an appearance in connection with

all court proceedings.

UNITED STATES' RESPONSE TO DEFENDANT'S STATUS REPORT

The United States of America, by and through its undersigned attorneys, respectfully submits the following:

As the defendant states in her status report filed at docket number 101, Special Agent Alisha Mahabir, another federal agent, U.S. Probation Officer H. Renee Moke, and the FPD investigator, went to Kmiec's father's house a few hours after the hearing on July 29, 2021. After the Court instructed the defendant to make the dogs available for inspection, the undersigned requested the inspection to be conducted immediately after the hearing. The purpose of this request was to prevent Kmiec from having time to move or hide any animals, or otherwise stage the animals in a misleading manner.

Unfortunately, it appears that Kmiec is still lying about the number of animals in her possession. Initially, Kmiec refused the undersigned's request to conduct the inspection immediately. After the undersigned insisted on the importance of conducting the inspection immediately, Kmiec finally agreed, and the inspection was conducted at her father's house a few hours after the July 29, 2021 hearing ended. However, Kmiec conducted the inspection of the three dogs in the entry way of the house, and she did not allow the agents or the Probation Officer to go beyond the entry way. Also, during the inspection, Special Agent Mahabir observed a box of cat food inside the house in plain view, and she requested to be able to look further inside the house to verify there were not any other animals. This request was denied—clearly because Kmiec was

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hiding other animals in the house. Indeed, during the underlying bankruptcy proceeding that preceded this criminal case, Kmiec was found keeping cats in cruel and inhumane conditions in addition to dogs.

Kmiec was given the benefit of the doubt at the July 29, 2021 hearing that she was being truthful when she admitted by attorney proffer to possessing three dogs. However, based on the presence of cat food inside her house, and her refusal to allow agents or the Probation Officer to verify that there were no other animals inside the house, it appears that Kmiec was not being truthful at the July 29, 2021 hearing.

COUNT ONE (Bankruptcy Fraud, 18 U.S.C. § 157(1))

I. <u>The Bankruptcy Process</u>

1. A voluntary bankruptcy case is begun by the filing of a bankruptcy petition, and the person who files that petition is a "debtor" under federal bankruptcy law. The process is conducted in a federal court and is governed by the United States Bankruptcy Code, which is found in Title 11 of the United States Code.

2. Bankruptcy is a process by which a debtor obtains relief from creditors (those who are owed money by the debtor). The process is designed to achieve an orderly transfer of a debtor's assets to the creditors in return for a discharge or release of the debts that the debtor incurred prior to filing for the bankruptcy. Therefore, it is important for the debtor to truthfully and accurately disclose their assets because a discharge depends upon the debtor's disclosure of a true and accurate picture of his or her financial affairs.

3. Upon the filing of a bankruptcy petition, a debtor is required by law to fully disclose his or her financial circumstances, including, among other things, assets, liabilities, and income.

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A bankruptcy "estate" is created upon the filing of a bankruptcy petition, which is a collective reference to all property in which the debtor has an interest.

4. The financial circumstances of the debtor are disclosed to the bankruptcy court by the debtor in a series of bankruptcy forms called the "Schedules of Assets and Liabilities," and on a separate bankruptcy form called a "Statement of Financial Affairs." The debtor signs these forms under the penalty of perjury.

5. A bankruptcy trustee is assigned to the bankruptcy case and is responsible for the administration of the debtor's bankruptcy estate, including the identification and liquidation of assets and the distribution of proceeds to creditors.

II. The Scheme and Artifice to Defraud

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¢,

6. Beginning on or about June 27, 2013, through on or about August 29, 2014, in the Southern District of Texas and elsewhere, the defendant,

ELAINE ANN KMIEC,

devised and intended to devise a scheme and artifice to defraud victim with initials K.V. of three dogs, specifically collies.

7. It was part of the scheme that KMIEC knew she had a poor reputation among dog owners in the greater Houston area due to her history of animal cruelty, and that it was unlikely anyone would agree to sell KMIEC any dogs if they knew her true identity.

8. It was further part of the scheme that KMIEC fraudulently concealed her true identity by falsely claiming to be "Sheila Kopman," in order to conceal her history of animal cruelty, and induce K.V. into selling KMIEC three collies under false pretenses.

9. It was further part of the scheme that when ordered to return the collies to K.V., KMIEC falsely claimed she was not in possession of the collies.

10. It was further part of the scheme that, for the purpose of executing and concealing the scheme and artifice to defraud, KMIEC filed a Chapter 13 petition for bankruptcy under Title 11, United States Code.

III. Violation

11. On or about May 29, 2014, in the Southern District of Texas and elsewhere, the defendant,

ELAINE ANN KMIEC,

having devised and intended to devise a scheme and artifice to defraud victim with initials K.V. of three dogs, specifically collies, and for the purpose of executing and concealing said scheme and artifice and attempting to do so, filed a petition under Title 11, United States Code, that is a Chapter 13 petition for bankruptcy in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court in Houston, Texas, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 157(1).

COUNT TWO (False Statement Under Oath, 18 U.S.C. § 152(2))

12. On or about August 29, 2014, in the Southern District of Texas, the defendant,

ELAINE ANN KMIEC,

knowingly and fraudulently made a material false statement under oath in and in relation to a case under Title 11, *Kaufman v. Kmiec*, adv. case no. 14-3216, and *In re: Elaine Ann Kmiec*, case no. 14-32964, by falsely testifying under oath at a hearing before a U.S. Bankruptcy Judge that there were 35 collies at her residence, when in fact the defendant knew that there were substantially more than 35 collies at her residence, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 152(2).

NOTICE OF CRIMINAL FORFEITURE 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c); 18 U.S.C. §§ 981(a)(1)(C) & 982(a)(2)

13. Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 981(a)(1)(C), the United States gives notice to defendant,

ELAINE ANN KMIEC,

that upon conviction of a violation of 18 U.S.C. § 152 as charged in the indictment, all property, real or personal, which constitutes or is derived from proceeds traceable to such offense, is subject to forfeiture.

Money Judgment And Substitute Assets

14. The United States gives notice that it will seek a money judgment against the defendant. In the event that one or more conditions listed in 21 U.S.C. § 853(p) exist, the United States will seek to forfeit any other property of the defendant up to the amount of the money judgment.
