This report profiles active women attorney members of the State Bar of Texas as of December 31, 2022. Not every attorney reports demographic data to the bar. Separate population totals are provided in italics in each category that is lacking all demographic data. Percentages may not sum to 100 due to rounding. Over the past 10 years the number of active State Bar of Texas women attorneys has increased by 40%, from 30,392 attorneys in 2012 to 42,484 in 2022.
