Dues Cycle

Bar Year is June 1 - May 31

- February-April: Auto-collections come from big firms.
 > This is about 40% accumulation.
- May 1: The dues statement goes out.
 > Increases are approved at the January Board Meeting.
- June 1: Dues are officially late.
 > Penalties are assessed on August 1.
- August 31: Members are suspended (or quickly pay!)
 Your membership starts to level out in September.

If you join March 15-May 31 you're a member for the next year!

Websites

- Create a website committee or hire a webmaster!
- Sections Dept. updates your council & newsletters.
- Your section supervises all content updates.
- Keep it up to date and looking nice.
- Sections Dept. can house your domain and hosting on a yearly auto-renew, but requires quick invoice approvals from you!
- Sections Dept. doesn't build or rebuild sites.
 > Big sites ≈ \$25k; WP sites ≈ \$5k; Rebuilds ≈ \$10k

Deadlines: The Rule of 3

- 3 Months for *Texas Bar Journal*
- 3 Months for State Bar Meeting Rooms
- 3 Weeks for Graphics
- 3 Weeks for Bylaw Amendments
- 3 weeks for MCLE Credit
- 3 days for Eblasts

Exception – 1 year for Retreats and CLEs!

Event Planning 101: Don't operate in crisis mode!



CLEs We Can Handle

- Smaller CLEs: ½ Day to 1½ Day programs.
- Less than 200 registrants.
 > Anything bigger needs to go to TexasBarCLE.
- Sections only get a single 1 hr webinar per month.
 > Webinars require at least 3 weeks notice.
- We can help with advertising bigger events.
- We *try* to staff...

Event Pricing Guide

- \$230-250 hotel nights is still the sweet spot.
- \$150 per person dinner is the recommended max.
- Casual/fun/funky dinners are good too!
- Adult beverages are OK, but not top-shelf.
- Hybrid is EXPENSIVE, stick to one or the other.
- Avoid car rentals -- rideshare is your friend.
- Just the council (+ maybe committee chairs).
- 1 pricier trip, 1 cheaper trip, justify the expense!

Beware. Be Aware!

- SBOT signs all contracts!
 > It usually takes 1-2 weeks
- Spring Retreats are EXPENSIVE!
 - > Switch it up -- at the start of your year, plan a Fall Retreat, spring could be your Council Meeting?
- Poll your council members before you have the Sections Dept. bid venues.
- The later you are in planning, the fewer will attend.
- We need prompt approval on all bills.



We Can Handle A Lot, But...

What you should already have done...

- Held an election (or have one coming soon).
- Sent us your full council roster.
- Notified us of any changes to your bylaws or dues.
- Turned in your budget.
- Assigned your committee chairs.
- Booked your meetings for the year.

- Assign Committees <<< If you haven't
- Review today's online materials.
- Create a Master Calendar.
- Update your website.
- Send a "We miss you" eblast to your non-renewals.
- Send a Welcome/Message from the Chair Eblast.
