- (1) whether the defendant had a property interest in the premises;
- (2) whether he [or she] was legitimately (lawfully) on the premises;
- (3) whether he [or she] had complete dominion and control and the right to exclude others;
- (4) whether he [or she] took precautions customarily taken by those seeking privacy;
- (5) whether he [or she] put the property to some private use; and
- (6) whether the claim of privacy is consistent with historical notions of privacy.
