Angela Downes is a Senior Professor of Practice at UNT Dallas College of Law in Dallas, Texas where she is Assistant Director of Experiential Education. Prof. Downes teaches clinical courses, the 40-hour mediation course, human trafficking and the law, as well as domestic violence and the law: an innovative approach to interpersonal violence. Her scholarship focuses on mediation, ADR, vicarious trauma, diversity, cultural responsiveness, and issues of interpersonal violence including domestic violence, human trafficking, and child abuse.
