Easy-to-understand information on frequently asked topics. Subjects include firearms law, tenants' rights, and marriage and divorce.

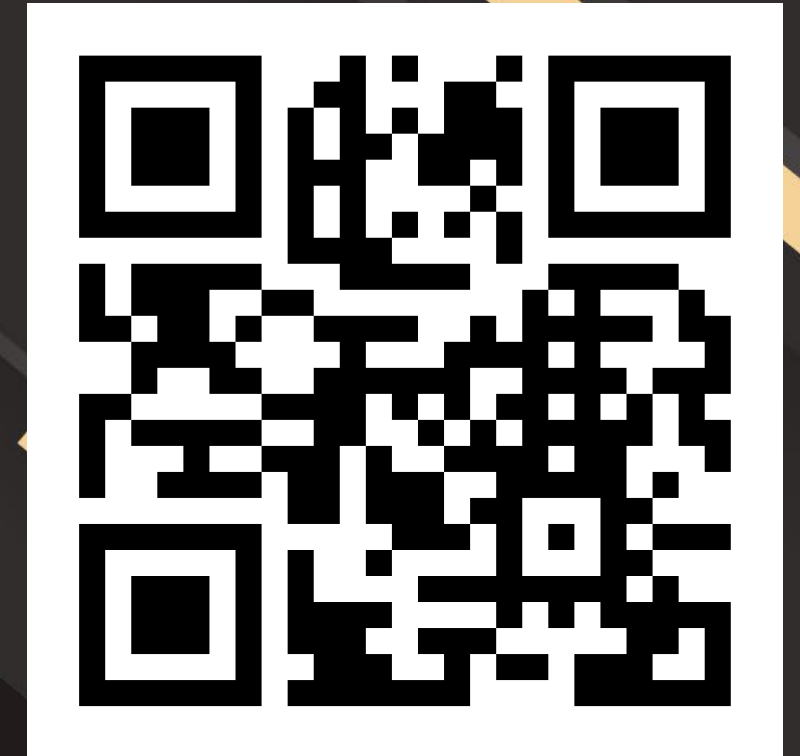

Remote access to databases like HeinOnline for law reviews, ALLALink for immigration law, and Fastcase for case law.

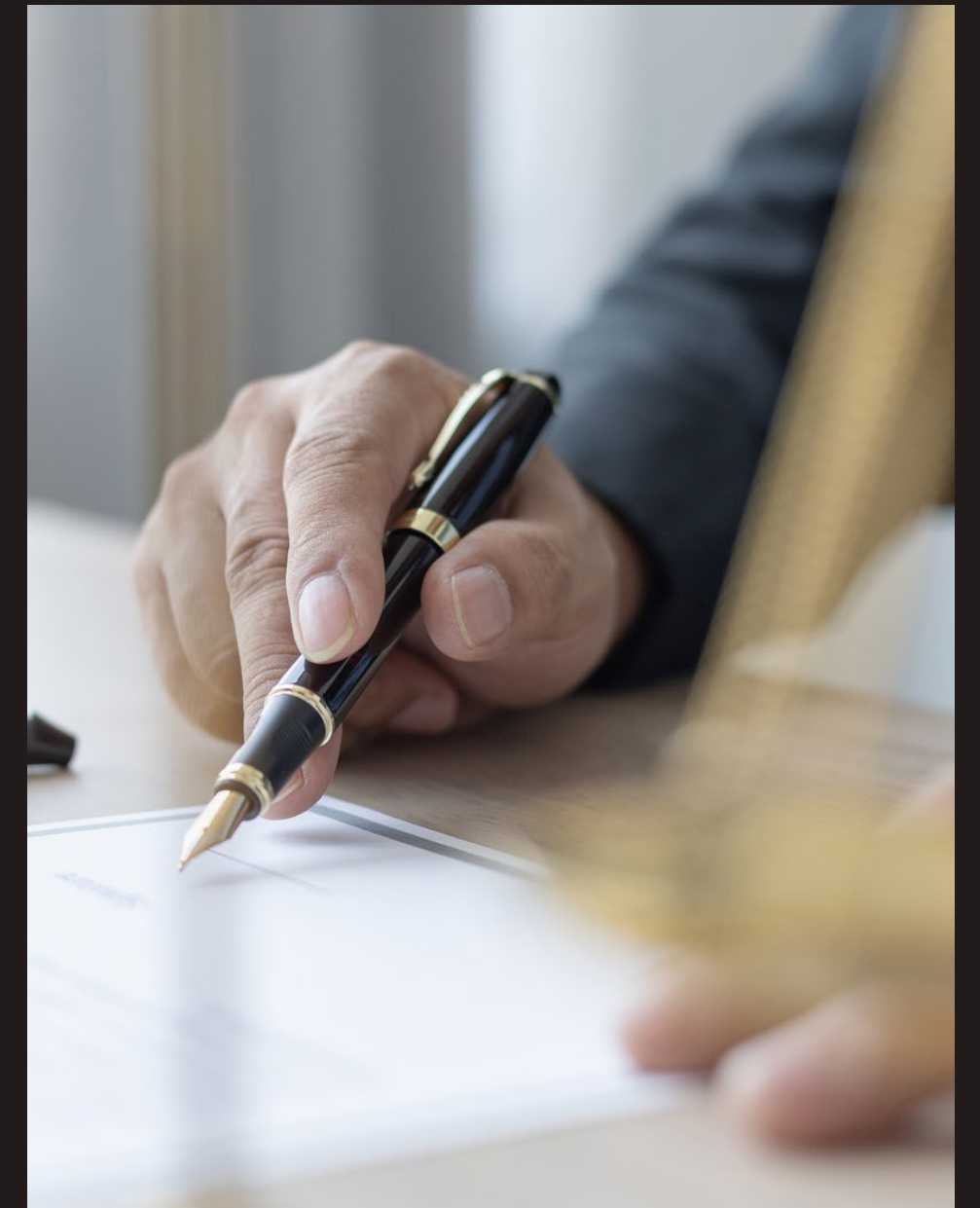
