

A Guide to What Things Should Cost.

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Website Pricing

- New Website Builds will run you...
 - \$20k \$25k for customized sites.
 - \$3k-\$5k for standard WordPress sites.
- □ A Website Refresh will run you...
 - \$8k \$10k for customized sites.
 - \$2k-\$3k for standard WordPress sites.
- Website Maintenance/Updates will run you...
 - \$4k \$14k per year.

Your Event Pricing Guide

- □ Hotel prices have skyrocketed.
 - Plan ahead and be flexible.
 - You pick 2 cities and 3 dates, we bid the hotels.
 - ✓ Confirm date options with your council BEFORE we bid!
- □ Spring is more expensive.
 - Can you switch it up... big fall retreats, modest spring meetings?
- Hybrid is not the friend you think it is.
 - Pick virtual OR in-person -- you will save money and get better attendance.

Hotel Pricing

- □ Aim for \$250 per night, max out at \$300.
 - We do still get great hotels for under \$200 -- it all depends on your date flexibility and how early you start the bidding process.
- □ Perception is important, pick 3 or 4 star hotels.
- Keep an eye on those resort fees and tourism taxes.
- The later you are in planning, the fewer will attend... and the less negotiating power we have!

Dinner Pricing

- □ About \$150 per person (includes meal, appetizers & drinks).
 - All in total bill should be \$3k-\$7k. A casual dinner should be under \$3k.
- Wine per bottle should be less than \$70.
- Cocktails need to be middle tier, typically called "premium"
 - Not wells, but not top shelf.
- Service fees are typically 20-25% (and are usually not a tip).
- Always tip, but be aware of already added group gratuities.

A/V Pricing

- □ Projector & Screen Packages cost about \$3k per day.
- Meeting wi-fi, cost approximately \$40 per person.
- □ Power strips comes out to around \$30 per cord.
- Service fees, Set-up & Strike, OH MY!
 (these on average make up 30-40% of your total A/V bill)
- You can bring your own A/V but that makes YOU responsible for transportation, setup, breakdown, etc.

Travel Pricing

- Encourage attendees to book flights early.
 - Direct flights are cheaper. Southwest typically has less fees.
 - Covering baggage & early check-in fees are ok -- never business or first class upgrades.
- □ If you fly, take a taxi/ride share -- no rental cars!
 - If you do approve rental cars, get the discount code from the Sections Dept. and <u>don't</u> get additional insurance.
- Know your reimbursement policy.

Tips & Take Aways

- Having a pricier meeting? Balance it out with a free Zoom meeting next time.
- Trying to spend down? Don't go wild -- Set a max rate and/or adopt a spend down policy.
- Plan, plan ahead... and don't be afraid to ask for help!
