Mr. Hennings is a Partner at Chisholm Chisholm & Kilpatrick, where he has practiced since January 2018. His legal focus is on the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and the U.S. Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims (CAVC). Prior to joining CCK, Mr. Hennings served as a Veterans Law Judge at the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, Board of Veterans' Appeals (BVA), a position appointed by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs with Presidential approval. He also worked as an attorney law clerk for the Honorable Alan G. Lance, Sr., at the CAVC, and held roles at the BVA, including Counsel in the Office of Quality Review and Associate Counsel. Mr. Hennings is an active leader in veterans' law, serving as the 2024-2025 Vice Chair of the State Bar of Texas Military and Veterans Law Section, and has been involved in numerous veterans' legal organizations.

In addition to his practice, Mr. Hennings has made significant contributions to veterans' law education, speaking and moderating at events hosted by organizations such as the CAVC Bar Association, Federal Circuit Bar Association, and National Organization of Veterans' Advocates. He is a published author, having written law review articles on veterans' law topics for the Federal Circuit Bar Journal and the Veterans Law Review. Mr. Hennings has also held leadership positions in various legal groups, including the CAVC Bar Association, the Federal Bar Association, and the NOVA Congressional Committee. Before his work in veterans' law, he practiced privately in northern New Jersey and clerked for the Honorable Robert L. Polifroni of the New Jersey Superior Court. Mr. Hennings holds a B.A. in History from George Washington University, an M.S. in Information Systems from Stevens Institute of Technology, and a J.D. from Rutgers University School of Law–Newark.
